We bundled up, put on our rain boots and hats and braved the weather, in search of a fine dining experience. Of course we didn't have to go far, only into downtown Petaluma to find one of Petaluma's favorite restaurants. Kabuki Sushi Bar & Japanese Restaurant. Kabuki has been pleasing both locals and tourists alike for seven years now.

Michael Chiang, one of the owners, greeted us at the door with a warm welcome to Kabuki. We were seated comfortably at a table with full view of the sushi bar. The interior was very pleasing. An old brick wall framed the restaurant on one side with the sushi bar parallel; this created a charming and friendly atmosphere. The décor included new birdseye maple chairs, adding to the overall aesthetics and comfort of dining experience.

Andy Ma, the Executive Chef /Co-Owner--originally from Hong Kong which some call "The Food Capitol of The World"--has quite a following in Petaluma. Each day he creates "Andy Specials" which gives diners a chance to try some new and creative dishes.

Christie, our server, was soon at our table with a friendly smile and told us about the menu and "Andy Specials" for the day. We ordered both hot and cold sake to start and were already feeling right at home. The restaurant was crowded for this rainy night with happy customers including families, couples and single diners, many of which appeared to be "regulars". Here are some of the dishes that we tried and recommend:
